St. Mark's Sunday worship and Wednesday Prayers services are broadcasted on Facebook, YouTube and St. Mark's website each week. **All services are available to watch after the initial broadcast time in addition to live stream.**

  - For best viewing on a television, we recommend that you subscribe to our [YOUTUBE CHANNEL](#) and watch using the YouTube app built into most TVs and all streaming devices (Apple TV, Roku, etc.).

  - Although you may be prompted to sign up for Facebook, you do NOT need to have a Facebook account to watch on Facebook.
  - If you do have a Facebook account, we recommend "Following" St. Mark's Episcopal Church Jacksonville so you are notified of new live streams.

## Tips for a successful viewing experience

- 1. Having good internet connection and bandwidth is very important!**
  - When possible, view on a hard wired connection (versus wireless).
  - Close out of other pages and only view the worship service from one device at a time. This will help to make sure your internet is not being stretched too thin.
  - *NOTE – Your Internet Service Provider, not St. Mark's, has control over your internet connection or bandwidth. If you continue to experience trouble, please contact your Internet Service Provider (Comcast, etc.).*
- 2. If one of the above platforms is not working, try a different one!**
  - Facebook may at times be non-responsive due to the number of concurrent users.
- 3. Try exiting and reentering the page if you have trouble viewing the broadcast.**
